Effective Leadership

- Review and update the school prospectus in line with current school policies and procedures.
- Submit a Minor Works application for the development and extension of the playground and for the installation of CCTV cameras around and throughout the school
- To complete the application process and partake in the PEACE IV initiative, pupils and staff working collaboratively with another school from a different management structure Spa Primary School.
- Coordinators to visit other schools or take part in Coordinator cluster meetings.
- To further develop the role of our link governors to ensure that they are fully involved in the life of our school.

A School Connected to its' Local Community.

- Extended use of Facebook and of school website to provide materials for parents to support children's learning.
- Seek sponsorships from local business to advertise their business on our school website to pay for the maintenance of the site.
- Rotate the Sacraments of Holy Communion and Confirmation on a yearly basis between the 2 chapels in the parish (Drumaroad and Clanvaraghan)
- Continue to support parents with parental workshops in Literacy, Numeracy and ICT (especially the whole school focus).
- To explore the possibility of using the Seesaw app into Foundation Stage enabling us to further celebrate each child's successes and further developing lines of communication between school and home.
- Develop further the links with Kids Kabin play group through visits of pupils and staff to ensure progression in transition.

SEN

- Liaise with the Educational Psychologist and consult on pupils requiring input from outside agencies.
- Further develop resources to enhance SEN teaching Numicon support and SEN Bug Club etc.
